Instructions:

1. Plug the cigarette lighter plug into the cigarette lighter receptacle. (If you are using the Battery Clips, connect the **Red** Clamp to the Positive (+) post of battery first, then connect the **Black** Clamp to engine or other suitable ground as far away from battery as possible.)
2. After use unplug the cigarette lighter plug or remove the "**Black**" (ground) clamp first, then the **Red** Clamp.
